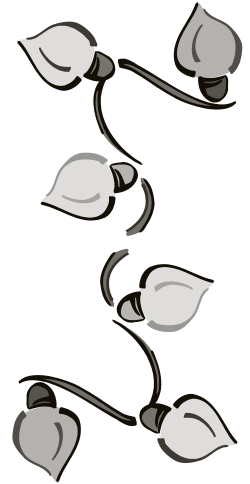
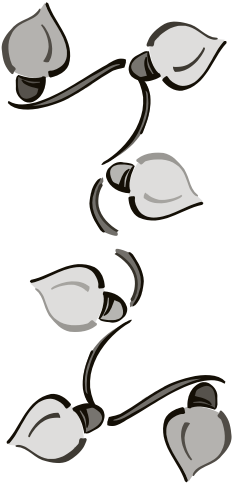
### **Bible Hill Garden Club Holiday Centerpiece Workshop**

## Message from the Chair

The Village of Bible Hill will be hosting several special Christmas Activities in the coming weeks. Please mark these events on your calendar: Village of Bible Hill Tree Lighting scheduled for Friday, December 4th, Light up Bible Hill competition on December 10th, as well as the presentation of the Light up Bible Hill winners on December 15th at the Village of Bible Hill Regular Monthly meeting.

On October 30th a new Bible Hill section of the Cobequid Trail was officially opened. This new section of trail goes through the Bible Hill Recreational Park and will connect onto the NSAC property in the near future. I would encourage you to experience this trail in the coming weeks.

On hand to help cut the ribbon were: Village of Bible Hill Commissioner Donna Van Kroonenburg, NSAC Executive Director Jim Goit, Town of Truro Mayor Bill Mills, Village of Bible Hill Chairwoman Sharon McLean, County of Colchester Mayor Bob Taylor, Nova Scotia Health Promotion and Protection Regional Representative Jim Campbell, and Village of Bible Hill Commissioner Robert Mahar.

Recently the Village Commission invited a representative of the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal to attend a Commission Meeting to review regulations regarding the criteria for crosswalks in the Village. The approval process includes measurement of traffic speed, traffic gaps, line of sight, stopping distance for vehicles and pedestrian usage.

The Village of Bible Hill has been approved for funding

under the Canada's Economic Action Plan Stimulus Fund. This project will include the replacement of the aging sewer pumping station located at the Bible Hill Recreation Park with a new gravity sewer line connecting to the trunk sewer system. In addition, we will be upgrading storm water lines in that area. The project is estimated to be \$1.8 Million with the Village of Bible Hill, the Province of Nova Scotia and the Government of Canada equally paying one-third of the cost. The Commissioners will be calling an Electors Meeting in the near future to present a borrowing resolution for this very important project.

Detailed design is underway for Phase 4 of the water project which will be constructed in 2010. The route for this phase will include a water line from East Court Road, down Pictou Road to Write Avenue, including Hazel Drive.

On behalf of the Commissioners of the Village of Bible Hill I would like to extend Season's Greetings to the residents of Bible Hill. Please have a safe and happy Holiday Season. I invite you to join your Village Commissioners at the 2010 New Year's Levy on Friday, January 1st, 1-2 pm at the Bible Hill Village Hall. Refreshments will be served.

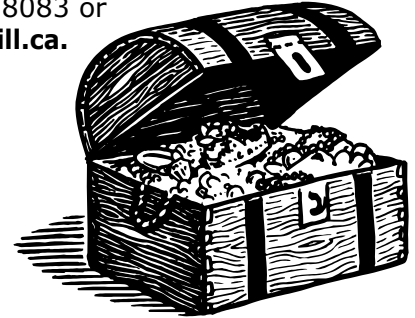


## Kidsport Grants!

## Pace Car Launch in Bible Hill



The Village of Bible Hill joined the growing list of Pace Car Communities. It launched the Pace Car anti-speeding program during the Safe Halloween Event at the Bible Hill Village Hall. The Pace Car program helps community members calm their streets, making them safer for those who use active transportation like walking and cycling.

Hundreds of children participated in safe trick or treating and their parents were given the opportunity to take the Pace Car pledge to become "mobile speed bumps." By doing so, they promise to drive the speed limit to slow speeding traffic on their streets. They also commit to display the Pace Car emblems on their vehicles. There are about 20 schools or communities throughout Nova Scotia involved in this program.

## Electors Meeting The Village of Bible Hill

Monday, December 7, 2009 at 7:30 pm  
The Village Hall, 69 Pictou Road

The purpose of the Electors Meeting is to seek approval from the electors of the Village of Bible Hill for the borrowing of up to \$750,000 to finance the Village's share of a Canada's Economic Action Plan Stimulus Fund project. This project will finance the replacement of an outdated sewer pumping station with a new gravity fed sewer line and the upgrading of the storm water system in the area of the Bible Hill Recreation Park.

An elector is of the full age of 18 years, a Canadian Citizen, and an ordinary resident of the Village of Bible Hill for a period of six months, continues to so reside and is qualified to vote under the provisions of the Municipal Elections Act.
