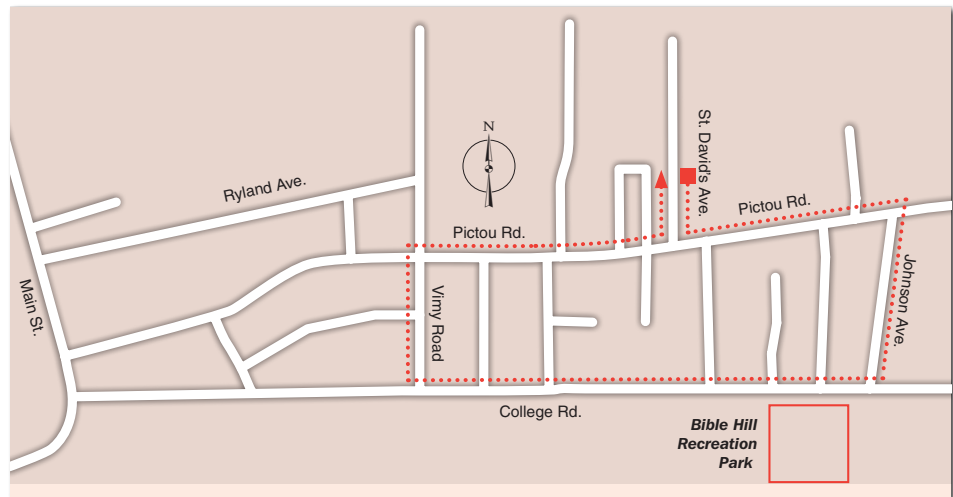

Street Parade: It is that time of year again to celebrate Canada's birthday! This year the Village of Bible Hill is promoting the theme *"65 Years of Bible Hill; Then and Now"*.

The **Grand Street Parade** begins at **10:00am**. It will start from St. David's Avenue, turning left onto Pictou Road. From there the parade will be turning right onto Johnson Avenue, and then another right onto College Road. The parade will continue onto Vimy Road, right onto Pictou Road and back to St. David's Avenue.
