

News from the Chair

With the close of 2018, the Village of Bible Hill marked 65 years of municipal government. We've made great progress over the years and we look forward to the work ahead. We are now already into the second month of 2019 with your elected officials and staff working on many projects and the daily operations of the Village on behalf of you, its residents.

Our Village has submitted an application for Federal-Provincial funding through the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program for a Phase V expansion to the municipal water system in Bible Hill. We are awaiting word on funding and are hoping for a positive result. If approved, the funding will cover more than 73 cents of every dollar of project cost, with the remaining 27 cents funded by the Village. The water expansion project will supply municipal drinking water service laterals to homes and businesses along Pictou Road between Main St and Vimy Rd and install fire hydrants to increase our fire protection capabilities. The plan will also see a reinstatement of new sidewalk, curb and gutter in the project area.

This fiscal year, the Village has ordered a new fire truck to replace our oldest of three, which has served now for about twenty-two years. The new modern pumper-tanker truck is currently being constructed and expected to arrive in Bible Hill in late summer.

Looking ahead, the Village Commission is working on the final touches of our budget for the upcoming fiscal year, which runs from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2020, I look forward to sharing more with you following budget approval.

Our Commission meetings are held regularly throughout the year and are open to the public. I invite you to consider attending to listen in on details of policy and happenings within the Village.

Notice of Nomination Period Nomination for Village Commissioners Village of Bible Hill



Two Commissioners for three (3) year terms, ending in June 2022.

Nominations for the office of Commissioner will be accepted May 9, 10, 13, 14, 15, and 16, 2019 between the hours of eight thirty (8:30 am) in the forenoon and four thirty (4:30 pm) in the afternoon.

All nominations shall be in writing on the prescribed nomination paper form and shall be filed with the Returning Officer at the Village Office. The Village Office is located at 67 Pictou Road, Bible Hill.

Qualifications of a Village Commissioner:

- 1) No person is qualified to serve as a village commissioner unless the person is an elector.
- 2) Every village commissioner shall take and subscribe the oath of office prescribed by the Municipal Elections Act in the manner prescribed by that Act before entering upon the duties of village commissioner.
- 3) A village commissioner whose term of office has expired is eligible for re-election.

An "elector" means a person resident within the Village entitled to vote at a municipal election, who will have resided in the Village for at least six months immediately prior to the Village election and:

- a) is of the full age of eighteen years on the first advance polling day;
- b) is a Canadian citizen on the first advance polling day;
- c) has been ordinarily resident in the Province for a period of six months immediately preceding the first advance polling day; and
- d) is ordinarily resident in the municipality or in an area annexed to the municipality and has been so since immediately before the first advance polling day, is entitled to be registered on the list of electors and to vote.
