

**Village of Bible Hill
Commission in Committee Meeting
May 10, 2022**



The Village of Bible Hill Commission in Committee meeting was held on May 10, 2022 in Commission Chambers, at the Village Office, 67 Pictou Road. Deputy Chair Van Kroonenburg called the meeting to order at 7:00pm; the meeting adjourned at 7:13 PM.

Call for new or other business and review and approval of agenda

Deputy Chair Van Kroonenburg called for new or other business, and Bell requested to add non-resident property tax under miscellaneous business.

Moved by Kennedy and seconded by Shea, that the agenda be approved, with the addition. Motion carried.

Call for declaration of conflict of interests

Van Kroonenburg called for any declarations of conflict of interest, and none were declared.

Miscellaneous business including delegations

Non-Resident Property Tax

Bell noted to the Committee that the Premier removed the recently introduced non-resident property tax, and that the deed transfer tax will proceed as planned.

New business

Dismantling Racism and Hate Act

Bell gave a brief overview of the Act of Dismantling Racism and Hate that was received to royal ascent on April 22, 2022. He noted that the Government shall create a strategy to address systemic hate, inequity and racism within the Province by July 31, 2023 and that prescribed public bodies shall also create a plan to address systemic hate, inequity and racism with the form and content, by the date prescribed. He noted the potential impact on local governments, should they be prescribed.

Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee Medal

Bell presented that the Province of Nova Scotia has introduced the Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee Medal. He noted that the ceremony will take place in July and nomination information will be available June 2nd. He then outlined eligibility and asked the Committee to consider if there were anyone they would like to nominate.

Procurement: BHFB Turnout Gear

Bell presented a quote from Nova Fire Equipment, for three sets of turnout gear. The quote was presented at \$11,230 plus HST. The Commission discussed.


