The meeting was held in Commission Chambers, at the Village Office, 67 Pictou Road. Van Kroonenburg called the meeting to order at 7:01 PM.

Call for new or other business and review and approval of agenda

Van Kroonenburg called for new or other business and Bell suggested to move Scenic Drive lots to closed session. Van Kroonenburg requested to add Deer under New Business.

Miscellaneous business or delegations

Van Kroonenburg welcomed Paul Weatherby, and he provided a brief oral report. He noted the County asked Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to forego the 3-year deer pellet count and move forward with a cull.

New Business

Procurement – Sidewalk renewals

Bell presented pricing for a sidewalk renewals project from Will-Kare at a cost of \$189,000 plus HST and from Webster Brothers at a cost of \$202,821.20 plus HST.

Bench dedication – Foster Stewart

Bell presented a commemoration request in memory of Foster Stewart for approval, noting the plaque is being donated and there is no cost to the Village

- Moved by Kennedy and seconded by Shea that the Commission in Committee recommend Village of Bible Hill approve the bench dedication for Foster Stewart. Motion carried.

Sponsorship request – Truro Pride

Bell shared a sponsorship request from Truro Pride to support their Pride Week events. The Committee asked to get more information, including whether other levels of government are also helping to fund Pride Week.

Deer

Van Kroonenburg talked about the large number of deer in the area. The Committee also spoke with Councillor Weatherby, about asking the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) to shorten the deer study so a deer cull can happen sooner.

- Moved by Shea and seconded by Pitcher that the Commission in Committee enter closed session.
