Re: Commissioner election results

Voting in Bible Hill for the election of two Commissioners closed today at 7PM.

A total of 273 ballots were cast, 148 of which were at the advance poll, with the remaining 125 at the ordinary poll held today.

The electors of Village of Bible Hill have voted to elect Thomas R. Burke and Tim Shea each to the Office of Commissioner. The newly elected Commissioners will serve terms through June 2023 and join Commissioners Donna Van Kroonenburg, Kevin Kennedy, and Knickolle Pitcher on the five-member Commission responsible for providing municipal services within Bible Hill.

The new Commissioners will be sworn in prior to their first meeting together as a group this Tuesday, November 17.

Said outgoing Chair Lois MacCormick, whose retirement took effect with today's election: "Residents have chosen to elect two great community minded candidates. The Village moves forward with a strong group of fellow residents to lead its community decisions. Congratulations to each of the five candidates on their campaigns and to Tom and Tim on their election to the Village Commission".
